This instruction manual will give you the knowledge (with screen shots) to set up your theme with ease. However, should you have any questions concerning your purchase, please go to our [Support Center](#) and open a ticket.

Getting Started

Your theme has been developed using the latest version of WordPress (which at the time of this publication is 3.9.1). If you do not have the latest version of WordPress it is highly recommended that you upgrade your site to ensure you experience the theme's full capabilities.

To get the latest version, [click here](#).

WordPress is extremely easy to get set up on your server - it comes with simple directions and you can be up and running within just a few short minutes. Once you have your WordPress set up and running, you can upload your theme and plugins and we will begin set up.

Please ensure you download 'All Files and Documentation!' from Themeforest. Once downloaded, you'll want to unzip the package.

To do this:

- Open your ThemeForest download - this is available from your downloads page at ThemeForest. Inside this folder you will see a number of other files such as squarecode-wp, squarecode-wp.zip, HELP FILE, Photoshop_Files.zip, WordPress_content_for_FES.xml, WordPress_content_without_FES.xml.
- The file you will be uploading to your “/wp-content/themes/” directory is the squarecode-wp. This directory contains all your necessary files for your theme. Alternatively you can take the squarecode-wp.zip and navigate to Appearance / Themes. Click the tab at the top that says ‘Install Themes’ and follow the onscreen instructions to upload the squarecode-wp.zip.
- Plugins are not included in the download, but later on you will see what plugins we used with links to download and setup. You can upload these plugin directories via FTP or just navigate to Plugins / Add New. Click the link at the top to ‘Upload’ and upload the .zip version of the plugin. Follow the onscreen instructions from there to set up and activate your plugins.
- Navigate to Settings / Media and set your thumbnail size to 300px (w) X 300px (h)
- It's now time to start putting the pieces together. If this is a fresh install of WordPress, you can login and delete the ‘Sample Page’ and the ‘Hello World’ post as well as remove all the default widgets that WordPress sets up for you on activation. To delete a page, navigate to ‘Pages’ from the WordPress admin, place your mouse over the title and click the ‘Trash’ to place in the trash (don't forget to empty the trash also!). To delete a post, navigate to ‘Posts’ from the WordPress admin and place your mouse over the title and click the ‘Trash’ to place in the trash (don't forget to empty the trash also! Finally to remove the widgets, navigate to ‘Appearance’ / ‘Widgets’ and click the arrow on each widget and select delete.
- Navigate to ‘Appearance’ / ‘Themes’ and find the screen shot for SquareCode-WP and click activate.
- Permalinks - You can set the permalinks to whatever you would like that makes sense to you. Please remember, leaving the permalinks as ‘default’ will not help boost your SEO.
- We will be setting up the content and admin settings next.

Theme Options Panel

Squarecode Admin Panel comes with a couple of areas that you will need to set up in order to finish your install. Everything is documented, but below you will find each section in more detail of what it does for your site. To access the Admin Panel, click on 'Appearance' and 'Theme Options'.

Setup

Top Logo

Upload your top logo to appear in the header. The size used in the live preview is 166px x 26px (transparent png).

Bottom Logo

Upload your bottom logo to appear in the header. The size used in the live preview is 166px x 26px (transparent png).

Favicon

This process works the same as above. Recommended size is 16px x 16px (transparent png).

Read More Button Text

Enter the text that will be used for your 'Read More' button. When you use the tag, this text will appear as your link to 'Read More'.

Tracking Code

This is where you need to place your tracking code for your analytics (such as Google Analytics) and the theme will call this code at the end of every page for your reporting needs - you may also use this area to input any JS you wish to use (do not load JQuery if you use for JavaScript as this is included in WordPress core!)

Custom CSS

This is an easy way for you to 'over-ride' any CSS that is in the style.css file. If you don't want an 'underline' on your links when someone hovers over it - simply navigate to this box and enter `a:hover: text-decoration:none;` etc depending on the class you want to change, (this was just an example).

Copyright Information

Enter your information to appear in the footer for your copyright. Basic HTML is also acceptable here!

Menu Title

Enter the text you want to appear beside your drop down menu icon.

Boxed?

Click the 'yes' or 'no' to indicate if you would like a boxed version of the theme or an unboxed version of the theme.

Homepage Featured Products Title

Enter the text you want to appear above the loop on the homepage that shows the 3 downloads from the EDD plugin that were given the category of Featured. Example: Our Featured Products.

Homepage Recent Products Title

Enter the text you want to appear above the loop on the homepage that shows the latest 6 downloads from the EDD plugin. Example: Our Latest Products.

Color and Image Sets

Body Background Image

Upload an image that will appear as the background-image for the body.

Body Image Repeat

Choose how you want your body background image to repeat. Repeat=this image will repeat horizontally and vertically. Repeat-x=this image will ONLY repeat horizontally. Repeat-y=this image will ONLY repeat vertically.

Body Background Color

If you choose to not do an image or an image that doesn't repeat, you can set your background-color here for the body, also if you are using the homepage template, the text, headings and link color will be taken from here.

Footer Background Image

Upload an image that will appear as the background-image for the footer area (where we show the newsletter form on the live preview).

Footer Image Repeat

Choose how you want your footer background image to repeat. Repeat=this image will repeat horizontally and vertically. Repeat-x=this image will ONLY repeat horizontally. Repeat-y=this image will ONLY repeat vertically.

Color 1

This color will be used for the breadcrumb wrapper background-color and links. It will also be the background color of the footer area if you did not choose the image upload option above.

Color 2

This color will be used for header wrapper background-color, all headings that are not links, footer wrapper background-color, input submit background-color, input submit text color, breadcrumb text color, the search input box in the header menu background-color, all input border colors - including submits, pull down menu side background-color, header post meta text color and caption background-color.

Color 3

This color will be used for the headings in the sidebar, all input borders and colors for contact page and comment forms, placeholder text color, all navigation items - top and bottom and the copyright.

Color 4

This color will be used for the page wrapper background-color, the footer widget text and links, the footer widget input, breadcrumb links and caption text color.

Color 5

This color will be used for list items and all text.

Color 6

This color will be used for all p text and list items in the sidebar.

Color 7

This color will be used as the background-color for the left side of the pull down menu and the homepage top widget section.

Plugins

As mentioned previously in the documentation, plugins are not provided as part of the download. Here is a list of the plugins we used in the live preview (should you wish to use them) as well as the links to those plugins.

Please note that plugins are created by many users, many for free, from all corners of the world, not all plugins play nicely together and it will be up to you to make sure the plugins you have activated are compatible with each other - this is not a limitation of the theme in any way - it's just if the plugin author created the code cleanly and using WordPress guidelines.

- [Contact Form 7](#) - used to power the contact form on the contact page.
- [Breadcrumb NavXT](#) - used to power the breadcrumbs. For the settings page - just leave the separator area blank, the theme will do the rest.
- [Cr3ativ Careers Plugin](#) - used to power the careers section of the site.
- [Cr3ativ Carousel Plugin](#) - used for all the carousels you see in the live preview.
- [Cr3ativ Portfolio Plugin](#) - used for all the portfolio areas you see in the live preview.
- [Cr3ativ Staff Plugin](#) - used to power the staff area of the live preview.
- [Creativ Shortcodes](#) - used for all the short codes seen in the live preview.
- [Responsive Lightbox](#) - used to power the lightbox seen in all galleries in the live preview. We use prettyPhoto for the lightbox effect.
- [AddThis Social Bookmarking Widget](#) - used for the pages where you see the social sharing.
- [Easy Digital Downloads](#) - used for the 'Downloads' custom post type.
- [Easy Digital Downloads - Related Downloads](#) - used in conjunction with EDD, add software specs and Software Application Microdata to your downloads when using Easy Digital Downloads plugin.
- [Easy Digital Downloads - Software Specs](#) - used in conjunction with EDD, add software specs and Software Application Microdata to your downloads when using Easy Digital Downloads plugin.
- [Easy Image Gallery](#) - used in conjunction with EDD to provide extra image uploads for each 'Downloads' item to show as a gallery under the featured image. For the settings page, we tell this easy image gallery to appear on 'Download' and we use the prettyPhoto lightbox.
- [Single Post Template](#) - used to power the ability to select fullwidth or default (right-sidebar) on each blog post.
- [WP Menu Cart](#) - used in conjunction with EDD to provide a cart icon with number of items and total cost in the menu.
- [Price Table](#) - used to power the pricing tables you see in the live preview.
- [Easy Digital Downloads - Product Reviews](#) - this replaces the WordPress comment form with a 'review form'. Please note this is a premium plugin that you will have to purchase and setup.

Page Templates

SquareCode comes with several page templates. Some of the page templates are ONLY used specifically for the plugins mentioned above.

Default Template

This is a regular right-sidebar page and uses the 'Page' widget section.

Cr3ativ-Careers

If you are using the Cr3ativ Careers plugin, this is a unique page template for bringing in all your career items and uses the 'Cr3ativ Careers Page' widget section.

Cr3ativPortfolio-3ColumnFilterable

If you are using the Cr3ativ Portfolio plugin, this is a unique page template for bringing in all your portfolio items.

Cr3ativStaff

If you are using the Cr3ativ Staff (profiles) plugin, this is a unique page template for bringing in all your staff members.

EDD Right Sidebar

If you are using the EDD plugin, this is a unique page template and uses the 'EDD Single Page Sidebar' widget section.

EDD-IndexPage

If you are using the EDD plugin, this is a unique page template that displays your 'downloads' as a filterable page much like the Cr3ativPortfolio template.

Fullwidth-Page

This is a fullwidth page template.

Home

This is a fullwidth page template that uses the 'Home Top' widget area to display slider (or whatever you wish) and your content from this page. Also has 2 loops for EDD (see details below)

Sitemap

This is a special template that will list your pages, posts etc. Simply create a new page - call it sitemap and choose the template - everything else is dynamic!

When creating your blog page, you just need to create a new page, name it and publish it. You do not need to choose a page template as WordPress has a specific php file used for the blog index page. Just remember to set it as your 'Posts page' as detailed later under the 'YOUR FRONT PAGE' section. Please remember all 'Blog' pages/posts (categories, author, archive, index and single post pages) uses the 'Blog' widget section.

Widgets


SquareCode comes equipped with several widget areas. Below we will go through each one.

Widget areas are simply a place for you to put whatever content you want and you have the option of choosing one of WordPress standard widgets such as 'Categories' or 'Pages', or even use a text widget to place any text or html that you would like. This theme will allow you to use your shortcodes in the widget areas should you choose the 'Text Widget'.

Next you will see screen shots and code snippets (if needed) to see how we set up our widget areas. First, to get to Widgets, click on 'Appearance' and then click 'Widgets'.

Cr3ativ Careers Page

We are using a default WP widget to show some text on the Cr3ativ Careers pages.



Content Import & Setup

Open up your 'SquareCode-WP-Package', inside there you will see an XML file. This is the exported content, pages, images etc from the live preview site.

The ONLY thing the XML import will not do is set up your admin and widget areas (which we've already covered above).

In the WordPress admin area, click 'Tools' > 'Import' > 'WordPress'. WordPress may ask you to install this plugin before allowing you to upload your file, just follow the on screen instructions to do this.

Once this is installed, click 'browse' and select the 'wordpress_content.xml' > 'open'.

From here you just need to select the 'Upload file and import'.

From the drop down on '-Select-', choose 'admin' and then make sure you click the box next to 'Download and import file attachments'. And that's it - your site should start looking very similar to the live preview.

If you do not choose 'admin' - you will not get any images!

If you get any error messages like 'Could not import....post type does not exist', it could be because you haven't got the theme activated or the plugin 'Contact Form 7' or one of the plugins that uses custom post types activated.

Menus

Your menu is already set up for you as in the live preview (if you did the XML import), but you will want to navigate to 'Appearance/Menus' and click 'Manage Locations' to make sure from the 'Theme Locations' (located in the top left) that everything is set up as it should be.

If you would like to have the icons appear next to your menu items as we did, you will have to assign a 'class' to them.

We use the icons we already have built in to our Cr3ativ shortcodes plugin and just re-use the same class names. With your XML import you received a page that is called 'Icons', or you can [click here](#) to view the page from our demo to determine what icons you would like to use for your menu icons.

Menus

SquareCode WordPress Menus and comes equipped with 3 menu areas.


Primary Menu – this is your ‘primary’ menu, make sure the main menu you want to see on your desktop is selected here.

Foot Menu – this is for the menu that appears in the footer.

Shopping Cart Menu – this is used in tandem with the WP Menu Cart plugin. You don’t have to place anything in this menu, but when configure the settings for the plugin, select this menu location as the destination for your cart (works with EDD, Woo and many other Ecommerce solutions).

You will need to make sure you go to the Appearance > Theme Options to place the text you want for menu in the correct location.

Once you create your menu(s) don’t forget to assign them to the correct menu location.



1. Click ‘create a new menu’ if you do not already have a main menu created.
2. Add your pages to this menu
3. Under the pages you just added you will have to assign the menu is a “Menu Settings” section - for the main menu click the “Primary Navigation” box
4. Click Save Menu
5. Repeat the steps above for the footer menu, but under the “Menu Settings”, click the Footer Menu
6. Repeat the steps above for the shopping cart menu - this area is only meant for 1 page/link or you can just create the menu, assign it under “Menu Settings” to the “Shopping Cart Menu” and leave it blank if you are planning on using the WP Cart Menu plugin mentioned above (settings for this section are listed at the end of this document)

WordPress Post Format

SquareCode utilizes the WordPress standard Post Format Types of 'standard', 'audio', 'link', 'gallery', 'video' and 'quote'. When you create your posts you just define the 'format' and the theme will style the heading of each post based on that format.

All posts display on the main blog page with text indicating their 'format', the author name (with author link), the date and title that links through to the article. The amount of text that shows on the index page is based on where you set the more tag, with the exception of link post format and quote post format.

All Post Formats will display the featured image (if you have set one) under the title and meta information with the exception of the link and quote post format.

Audio Post Format

The audio post form works just like a regular post. But with WordPress 3.9 all you need to do to add an audio file is either copy/paste the URL to the audio file in the content area or click the 'Add Media'/'Create Audio Playlist' and select your audio files from the library and insert the audio playlist. Where ever you place the play list (before or after the more tag) is where it will appear on the blog and single pages.

You will see the shortcode etc if you import the XML.

Video Post Format

To place a video in the post, you can just dump the iframe code supplied by the video service in the Text editor, however, if you are using the Creativ Shortcodes plugin, in the Visual Editor you can click cr3ativshortcode and see the pop up. Select Video, then from the drop down select either Vimeo or Youtube, from there you ONLY need to place the URL to the video, no iframe code is necessary.

With WordPress 3.9 you can now create a video playlist for self hosted video's uploaded to your media library exactly the same way you did the Audio Playlists with the exception of click 'Add Media'/'Create Video Playlist'. The above reference on using the video shortcode from Cr3ativ Shortcodes still stands if you are using a Vimeo or Youtube video URL.

Gallery Post Format

For the gallery post format, this works just like a regular post, you insert your gallery wherever you want it to appear - if you used the lightbox plugin we linked to earlier then your images in a standard WordPress gallery will be clickable to show a full size image in a popup shadow box - to achieve this the image must be Linked To 'Media File' when creating your gallery.

Quote Post Format

For quote post format, there will be no link to 'click-through', you just place the text you want to appear and the theme will do the rest. The content will be the actual quote.

Link Post Format

For link post format, we do not allow for a 'click through' to that actual post, but we extract the first link and link text in the post, and that will appear on the blog index page and will be clickable to your visitors.

Standard Post Format


For standard post format, this works just like a regular post, you can set a featured image or not, it's totally up to you! The amount of text that appears before the more tag is based on where you place the more tag. The 'Read More' text is pulled from your theme options.

Setting Your Front Page in WordPress

Navigate to 'Settings' and then 'Reading' and set the front pages as Static and choose "Home" for the "Front Page" and "Blog" for the "Post Pages" as in the image below.

We tell WordPress to 'discourage search engines', obviously you wouldn't want to do that, but since this is just a demo site, we have this clicked.



You must have a license number to register the product at the support center - this is available from your downloads page at ThemeForest - look for the item on the page and click the drop down - that's the license right there :)



Other plugins used though out the live preview are mentioned earlier in the documentation, each has it's own settings that you will need to configure to what's best for your business model. The only plugin I will mention here is the WP Cart Plugin. We have created a menu called 'Shopping Cart Menu', as you can see from the screen shot below, we have nothing in this menu:



This is because we tell the WP Cart Menu plugin to use this menu to display the cart:



If you are using the homepage template as your static homepage, there is a built in loop for the Easy Digital Download items. The first loop brings in 3 'downloads' as long as they have the category of 'Featured' assigned to them.

The next loop (under the hr) is the latest 6 'downloads', in the most recent first order. The theme options panel allows you to place a title above each of these loops of what ever text you wish to display above each loop.

We are also using the Easy Digital Downloads - Product Reviews plugin. The settings for this plugin is located under the 'Downloads > Settings > Extensions' menu option from the WordPress admin:
